TIMELINE

- **1914-1918. First World War.**
- **1934. Greece.** Women rights.
- **1938-1945. Italy.** Racial laws passed by the fascist government.
- **1939-1945. Second World War.**
- **1939-1975. Spain.** Dictatorship of Francisco Franco.
- **June, 1940. Latvia.** The USSR occupation in Latvia.
- **1940-1943. Italy.** War crimes in Montenegro, Slovenia and Albania.
- **1945-1989. Poland. Communism time** (Martial Law in 1980, omnipresent censorship during the whole period of Martial law, the Home Army officers' liquidation).
- **March, 1949. Latvia.** Deportations of the population of Latvia.
- **1967-1974. Greece.** The Junta.
- **1968-2011. Spain.** ETA Terrorist Attacks.
- **1983. Latvia.** Legal proceedings against dissident Gunārs Astra.
- **July, 2001. Italy.** The police forces the barricades and hits people who were protesting against the G8 in Genoa.
- **2008. Poland.** Claudiu Crulica's death.
- **2010. Greece.** Memorandum
- **20th century – present. Spain.** Discrimination of immigrants.
